All Hunter Classes will be judged under the SHB (GB) 2023 Society's Rules.

Classes 2 - 7 are qualifying events for the RIHS 2023 and only Horses registered on the SHB(GB) Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and Owners and Riders must be Members of the Society. The two highest placed Horses in classes 2 – 7 will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No Horse lower than second in its Class will qualify.

**Day Ticket = £36** (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

Competitors in classes 2-7. It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards:

All PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017: ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016: AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards; It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats.

#### **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
- 2. This Show is run in accordance with the 2023 Rules of the British Show Horse Association.
- 3. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by the Exhibitors, Riders or their Horses or any other person connected. Entries are accepted on this basis.
- **4.** The Organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if there are insufficient entries, or to amend conditions of any class at their discretion.
- **5.** While every effort will be made to avoid classes clashing, the Show cannot be held responsible if due to large entries classes overrun.
- **6.** Novice classes are open to registered Hacks, Cobs, Maxi Cobs, Riding Horses and Hunters which have not won a first prize of £35 or more or a total of £250 in any showing classes affiliated to the BSHA, at home or abroad, prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Winnings gained as a 4 year old are exempt unless the animal has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £35 or more. A Novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle.

#### 7. RULES FOR BSHA RISING STAR CLASSES

Available to amateur members and non-members (aged 15 and over) please see Rule 7 in 2023 BSHA Rulebook.

Open to horses which have never been placed in the top 9 in any class at a HOYS Final (not including SFAS, but to include the top three placings in the SEIB R2R Final); and riders not to have competed at HOYS in the current season and two years prior to the current season (not including SFAS).

Open to horses which have never been placed in the top 9 in any RIHS BSHA Open Final at Hickstead.

No competitor previously deemed a showing Professional / Producer, may be permitted to enter these classes.

JMB certificates will not be required to compete in these classes.

- 8. Hard hats must be worn at all times whilst riding and leading horses on the showground.
- 9. DOGS are allowed on the Showground but MUST be kept on a lead any dog fouling must be cleaned up.
- 10. MUCKING OUT OF HORSESBOXES IS PROHIBITED ON THE SHOWGROUND.

Novice Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob and Riding Horse: A Novice is a Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob or Riding Horse that has not won a first prize of £35 or more, or more than a total of £250 (including any Championship Prize Money) in any showing classes excluding Working Show Horses, Best Trained, Pairs, Side Saddle, or In-Hand classes that were Affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. Winnings as a 4 year old are exempt, unless that 4 year old has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £35 or more. If the category has changed from a Hack to a Riding Horse or vice versa, it may not revert back to a Novice. Snaffle bridles may be worn for Novice classes. Novice animals must be Registered with the Association or Exhibitors must have purchased a 'Day Ticket' in order to compete in Novice classes. Animals which have been placed in the top five at either the Royal International Horse Show or Horse of the Year Show in any OPEN ridden class, BSHA or otherwise, with the exception of the Search for a Star finals, are ineligible to compete in Novice Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob or Riding Horse classes. Horses competing in Novice classes must be ridden by the Judge, before being asked to "strip" for conformation.

#### **BSHA HUNTER CLASSES**

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Owners, Riders & Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Horses registered with the Association must be Owned, Exhibited and Ridden by current BSHA Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

**BSHA Novice Hunters:** Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 158cms. Capable of carrying up to 79.5kgs (12 stone 7lbs) for LW, 79.5kg (12 stone 7lbs) and not exceeding 89kgs (14 stone) for MW & over 89kgs (14 stone) for HW. Not to have won a first prize of £35 or more, or more than a total of £250 (including any Championship Prize Money) in any showing classes excluding Working Show Horses, Best Trained, Pairs, Side Saddle, or In-Hand classes that were Affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to 1st January in the current year. Winnings as a 4 year old are exempt, unless that 4 year old has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £35 or more. If the category has changed from a Riding Horse to a Hunter or vice versa, it may not revert back to a Novice. Snaffle bridles may be worn for Novice classes. Novice animals must be Registered with the Association or Exhibitors must have purchased a 'Day Ticket' in order to compete in Novice classes. Animals which have been placed in the top five at either the Royal International Horse Show or Horse of the Year Show in any OPEN ridden class, BSHA or otherwise, with the exception of the Search for a Star finals, are ineligible to compete in Novice Hunter classes. Horses competing in Novice classes must be ridden by the Judge, before being asked to "strip" for conformation.

Royal International Horse Show (RIHS) Qualifying Classes: Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. BSHA Registration numbers must be quoted on Entrymaster when entering. The Royal International Horse Show: The First Prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

**Direct Qualifiers for Finals at London International Horse Show** (LIHS 13-18th December 2023): The highest placed unqualified in top 3 to qualify. If second and third are unqualified, they will qualify for the BSHA qualifier (semi-final) at Addington Equestrian Centre on the Sunday 10th September. Qualification for Rising Star Supreme Final or BSHA National Championship Semi-Final will not go beyond third place.

Available to amateur members and non-members, please see Rule 7 in 2023 BSHA Rulebook.

Open to horses which have never been placed in the top 9 in any class at a HOYS Final (not including SFAS, but to include the top three placings in the SEIB R2R Final); and riders not to have competed at HOYS in the current season and two years prior to the current season (not including SFAS).

Open to horses which have never been placed in the top 9 in any RIHS BSHA Open Final at Hickstead. Competitors do not have to be members to compete in the direct qualifiers, however all competitors who receive their qualification to the LIHS BSHA Rising Star Supreme Final must complete their membership and registration with the BSHA within 7 days for their qualification to stand or this will pass down the line.

No competitor previously deemed a showing Professional / Producer, may be permitted to enter these classes. JMB certificates will not be required to compete in these classes.

The Judge will NOT ride exhibits in these classes.

Turley & Gill Amateur Home Produced Qualifier: Owners, Riders and Horses must be registered with BSHA or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Riders must be 15years of age or older. This class is a qualifier for the Turley & Gill Family Amateur Home-Produced Supreme Final to be held at the BSHA National Championship Show. Open to horses to be Home-Produced and ridden by an Amateur; please see rule 7 in 2023 BSHA Rulebook for Amateur Home-Produced definition. Horses must be registered as a either a Hack, Cob, Maxi Cob or Riding Horse. The two highest placed unqualified in the top five will qualify for the final at the BSHA National Championship Show.

**BSHA SUPREME OF THE YEAR:** The 1st or highest placed prize winners in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA SUPREME OF THE YEAR FINAL for Hacks, Cobs, Riding Horses, Maxi Cobs and Hunters, if they are registered with the BSHA or have purchased a Day Ticket for the Championship Show, in which case their membership will be accepted by the BSHA Office for the National Championship Show. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Shows in September 2023.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse and RIHS Hunter classes).

**SPORTS HORSE BREEDING CLASSES**: All SHB(GB) Hunter Classes will be judged under the SHB (GB) 2023 Society's Rules. Classes 2-7, 16, 18 are qualifying events for the RIHS 2023 and only Horses registered on the SHB(GB) Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and Owners and Riders must be Members of the Society. The two highest placed horses in each class will qualify to enter at the RIHS. In the Working Hunter Class the three highest placed horses will qualify or in the case of two Working Hunter Classes (i.e. Lightweight and Heavyweight) the four horses forward for the Championship will qualify. No horse lower than second in its Class will qualify.

**Day Ticket = £36** (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days.

All Hunters, including Ladies and Small, are barred from entry in the Hack and Riding Horse classes at the same Show on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

Please refer in all cases to the Sports Horse Breed (GB) Rulebook 2023.

This show is a qualifier for the IDHS(GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge.

The highest placed horse/s (not already qualified) from each of the above/following (delete where appropriate) Classes 19 and 20 will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge which will be held at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 2nd & 3rd September 2023 at Onley Equestrian Centre, Onley Grounds Farm, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ.

A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Qualifiers will be contacted by a member of the IDHS Show Team. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhsgb.org.uk to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the final.

In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, and a trophy the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Purebred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, and the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50.

#### Amateur definition:

The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:

Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.

Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st 2022

Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season. A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show.

Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disgualification from future classes.

#### **Tattersall RoR Open Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2023**

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavasson noseband. Horses should be plaited. **The first THREE go forward to the championship at Hickstead on June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023.** All entries **MUST** be competition registered with the RoR and include their competition registration number on entry form and have **RACED in GB.** All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force.
