Any combination who has 2 wins or more in BD or unaffiliated classes with more than 15 entries in each must compete at the next level above. Any combination, who has scored more than 72% or above in a class at a military championship (including UK Armed Forces Dressage Championships in the last 2 years) must compete at the next level above. Any combination who has qualified for and ridden at the National Championships (BD or BRC) in the last 2 years, must compete at the next level above if they achieved 70% plus (at the level below).

1. Introduction

Addington Equestrian are running the UK Armed Forces Equestrian Championships (UKAFEC) 2023 on behalf of the UK Armed Forces Equestrian Association (UKAFEA) with technical advice as necessary from the UKAFEA Events Director. UKAFEC is organised in accordance with Joint Services Publication 660, the UK Equestrian National Governing Bodies (NGB) rulebooks complemented by the UK Armed Forces Equestrian Association (UKAFEA) Competition Policy 2023.

2. Agreement To Be Bound By The Rules

Every competitor, by the completion of his/her entry form, agrees to be bound by the rules of British Dressage, British Showjumping and UKAFEA Competition Policy. It is the responsibility of all competitors to familiarise themselves with these rules and accept specific instructions from Addington Equestrian staff, judges and officials in addition to the UKAFEC Event Team.

3. Liability

So far as permitted by law, Addington Equestrian, its officers, employees, representatives and UKAFEA will not be liable to any person whatsoever whilst upon, entering, or leaving the Showground for any loss, damage, death injury or accident to persons or property or for lost or stolen items.

Each Exhibitor must keep Addington Equestrian its officers, employees, representatives and UKAFEA fully indemnified against all losses, actions, costs, claims, demands and expenses arising directly or indirectly out of any act, omission or negligence by him or by one attending the Show, in connection with his entry or otherwise expressly or impliedly with his authority. Therefore, all Exhibitors, Competitors and Owners are strongly advised to take out third-party liability insurance. Addington Equestrian cannot advise on policies or their suitability and it is the individual's responsibility to obtain advice wherever necessary. Exhibitors, Owners and Competitors are personally responsible for ensuring that they take all necessary measures with regard to health and safety.

The attention of exhibitors with stallions is drawn to BS Rule 82.21. No member of the BS/BD shall allow a stallion for which he is responsible, as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

4. Sponsors

5. Rider Eligibility - Priority Categories

In order to compete at UKAFEC riders must meet the criteria of one of the following priority groups. (In the event of classes being over-subscribed, or an unequal % proportion of entries, a ballot of priority groups may be necessary). This reflects the fact that UKAFEC is primarily a military championship and therefore military competitors will have precedence with a proportion of associate riders from the uniformed Blue Lights community (Emergency Services and Protective Services), military Saddle Clubs, military dependents, MOD civil servants and military veterans communities. **Therefore it is imperative that as part of the entry process competitors must declare themselves in a priority category from the below:**

- (1) **Priority 1:** Serving Regular and Reserve UK Armed Forces personnel (including foreign military personnel serving in UK units).
- (2) **Priority 2:** Member of a military Saddle Club (over the age of 16) recognised by single Service Equestrian Associations.
- (3) **Priority 3:** Blue Lights community (Emergency Services and Protective Services) uniformed staff. Proportionally not more than 10% of total entries. This rule may be waived to allow Police Force riders to compete in the London International Horse Show qualifier.
- (4) **Priority 4:** Member of the MOD Civil Service or Recognised Cadet Force (over the age of 16). Proportionally not more than 5% of the total entries.
- (5) **Priority 5:** Veteran Service personnel and dependents over the age of 16. Proportionally not more than 5% of the total entries.

6. Under 18s

Anyone under the age of 18 attending the competition, in any capacity, must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. If a responsible adult is not an immediate family member, or legally appointed guardian, the responsible adult shall be notified to the Secretary in the Notes of their entry. For Service personnel this will be the single Service Team Manager. All guardians are also to read and abide by the regulations detailed in this instruction.

7. Horse Eligibility

Horses/ponies:

- a) Must be a minimum of 4 years old for jumping and dressage classes as per relevant NGB regulations.
- b) May be completed by more than one rider during the show however, the horse may only compete once per class unless the second rider is competing HC.



c) Teams of 3 Showjumping only:

- Horses / ponies can be ridden twice on the same team if ridden by two different riders. A rider may not ride more than once for the same team.
- A horse and rider combination may compete on a maximum of 2 teams but must not jump in the same section for both teams.
- The horse will not be accepted in this class more than twice.
- A rider with more than one horse may compete on multiple teams.

8. Entries

Key entry information:

Closing Date: Friday 25 August after which the priority categories (see paragraph 5) will be balloted.

Any entry made without a priority category in accordance with paragraph 5 above will be rejected.

The Show may at its absolute discretion, decline any entry, or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign any reason or being liable for any compensation.

In the event that a cheque has to be re-presented to the bank, each time a £15 charge will be added to the rider's account.

Entry fees that are not received in full, one week before the event, will be cancelled.

9. Refund of Entry Fees

Refunds will only be made in accordance with BS/BD Rules and not at all after 12 noon on Friday 8 September prior to the event. Stabling fees will not be refunded.

The Organizers reserve the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the Classes in accordance with BS/BD rules.

Electronic signature by the person making the entries shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the Terms and Conditions of the Schedule.

10. Competition

Order of Competing. The order of competing for classes in all arenas each day, will be drawn. Horses must compete in the order they appear on the Running Order, which will be posted. Times/order for Dressage and showjumping can be viewed online at www.addington.co.uk, the Equipe App or the Secretary's office. Drawn orders will not be available before 6pm the day before the class unless special permission has been obtained from the Judges. **All Times are approximate and subject to change.**



11. Substitutions

Are in accordance with BS/BD Rules.

12. Standard

In exceptional circumstances when a standard set by the Judges has been reached, any competitor making more than the fixed number of penalties shall be retired.

13. Prize Giving

Prize giving's are compulsory and prizes will be withheld for those who do not attend mounted or dismounted (Showjumping after each class / Dressage at pre-allotted times). There will be rosettes awarded to 6th place and prizes in kind.

Official photographs of prize winners will be taken and used for PR purposes - anyone not wishing their photo and name to be used in UKAFE PR material is to make this known to the show's military PR Lead.

14. Dressage Arena Walks.

Dressage competitors will be given an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the arena at a defined time which will be overseen by a steward. Bridle numbers should be worn if taking part in the arena walk. Competition dress is not required but appropriate safety equipment must be worn to comply with British safety standards.

15. Warm-up Arenas.

Competitors will be provided with surface arenas for warm up prior to their class times. Restrictions to the warm-up arenas (Jumping only, Dressage only) will be clearly signposted and are to be strictly adhered to. Stewards will control the use of the arenas and competitors may be asked to vacate if the numbers warming-up exceed capacity and therefore create unsafe conditions. Competitors within 20 mins of their SJ/Dressage time take precedence in warm up arenas.

16. Stallions.

Stallions are permitted at the show centre. Stallion disks and white ribbons are to be clearly displayed at all times. When led in hand an appropriate chain is to be fitted. It is the responsibility of the owner, lessee, Authorized Agent, or rider to take adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury.

17. Hors Concours (HC)

A horse or rider may be allowed to take part in a class 'Hors Concours' (HC - non-competitively) subject to the following conditions:

- a) No prize money, qualification or placing may be won.
- b) The rider is subject to the Rules as if he/she were a competitor i.e. must follow the set track and leave



the arena if eliminated.

- c) For showjumping, may do so once in the first round of the competition only and is not to participate in the jump off other than the jump off section of a single phase or two-phase competition.
- d) A horse or pony that has competed HC is not allowed to compete subsequently for prizes in the same arena on the same day.

18. Objections

- a) Objections should be made in writing in accordance with BS/BD Rules. A £100 deposit in cash will be required per objection.
- b) Objections for the Inter-Services Leg and London International Horse Show Qualifier will be as per specific rules laid down in the UKAFEA Competition Policy which also gives guidance on any disciplinary action that can be taken as a result of the action of a military attendee.

19. Horse Health

Vaccination Against Equine Influenza

All horses at the Show must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza. There will be random checking of certificates and any horse or pony found without a valid certificate will not be permitted to remain on the showground. All competitors (National and International) must have up to date vaccinations (within 12 months) as per BS and BD regulations.

20. Addington Services

a) Stabling

Stables may be booked for the duration of the Show. Stables must be booked on the entry system. Competitors wishing to check that their stable reservation has been confirmed should contact the Entries Secretary.

b) Arrival and Departure at Show

The stable area will be open from 14:00 on the day before the event If you have booked stables for the duration. If you have booked individual day stables they are available from 17:00 to 16:00 the following day. Competitors may not arrive between the hours of 20:00 hrs and 0600 hrs without prior arrangement with the Show.

c) Bedding and Forage

Shavings, fodder, haylage and hay can be purchased on site from Stable Manager.



d) Electric Hook Up

A limited number of electric hook ups are available. The power source is via a generator. The event will endeavour to provide continuous supply but cannot guarantee this.

e) Medical Charge

Paramedic cover will be provided during the competition. Competitors are required to contribute £5 per day towards medical cover which will be included as part of the entry process.

f) Farrier and Veterinary Services

The services of a vet & farrier are not available at the show. Owners and/or the person responsible are responsible for any costs incurred.

g) Tented Camping is permitted by prior arrangement and a pitch can be booked through Equipe.

h) Catering.

The onsite cafes will be open during the event. They will provide a service on the days of competition throughout show hours providing hot and cold food, drinks and snacks. There is a licensed bar in the evenings (including evening of arrival). Competitors are reminded that only food and alcohol purchased on the premises may be consumed in the show centre, and outdoor associated seating areas.

21. Competition Dress

Serving military competitors. (Any exception must be agreed with the arena judge and UKA/FEA Events Director prior to the class commencing). Below are the expected dress standards but in view of the time of year short sleeve order may be declared:

- a) Navy. No 1 Service Dress, black or navy breeches. Foul weather jackets in the event of inclement weather.
- b) Army. In order of priority, as appropriate to service orders of dress/personal issue and weather conditions; No 2 or Service Dress, issue or beige breeches, full length boots, Jumper order (c) Combat jackets
- c) Royal Air Force. No 1 Jacket, beige breeches and black boots.



- d) Emergency and Protective Services - equivalent uniform to military personnel or civilian attire as appropriate
- e) Non-uniformed serving competitors. Civilian attire is to conform to current BS and/or BD rules. Any exception must be agreed with the Show Secretary prior to the class commencing.

22. Restrictions

- a) **Motor Bikes Scooters and Bicycles.** Motorbikes, scooters & bicycles will not be permitted anywhere on the showground.
- b) **Estate.** Under no circumstances may any horse go on to any other areas of the estate, other than that area designated for the event. Any horse found outside of the designated area will be eliminated from the show.
- c) **Points/results.** Restrictions to competitors with BS points or unaffiliated results are as stated in the Schedule. Point limits, unless otherwise stated, refer to the lifetime achievement of the horse not the horse and rider combination. Applications for exemptions may be made in writing to the Secretary by no later than the close of entries and will be referred to the UKAFE Events Director.
- d) **Cumulative Class limitations.** A horse and rider combination is able compete at two consecutive levels in SJ and/or Dr (e.g. 75cm and 85cm, Preliminary and Novice). This applies to the combination, a rider may compete different horses at other levels; likewise a horse may be competed at other levels by a different rider, provided class restrictions are not breached, but sub para 22.f. below still applies.
- e) **Dressage level restrictions.** Any combination who has 2 wins or more in BD or unaffiliated classes with more than 15 competitors in each must compete at the next level above. Any combination who has scored more than 72% or above in a class at a military championship (including UK Armed Forces Dressage Championships in the last 2 years) must compete at the next level above.
- f) **Horse welfare restrictions.** Horses/ponies will not be accepted in more than 4 classes (SJ or Dr or a combination of) per day with the same or multiple riders.

23. Health Safety and Security

In addition to Addington Equestrian safety protocols a UKAFEC military Safety Management Plan, incorporating Addington Equestrian risk assessments and safe systems of work will be managed alongside additional MOD actions in the event of an incident. The UKAFEC military Safety Manager and Assistant will complement the Addington Safety organisation.

24. Important Information For All Exhibitors

- a) A 5mph speed limit will be strictly enforced within the showground.
- b) Open fires will not be allowed under any circumstance. Purpose built Barbeques will be allowed under strict supervision.
- c) Horses must not be left tethered or unattended whilst out of the stable or transporters under any circumstances.
- d) Dogs off leads are strictly forbidden on the show ground and are not allowed in the buildings.



- e) The main fire point is located at the stable manager's office.
- f) All horses must remain within the designated areas and walkways at all times. It is strictly forbidden to exercise or move horses in any areas other than those designated as walkways, warm up areas or stabling area.
- g) The stabling areas are designated as no smoking areas.

25. Fire Procedure

In the event of a fire:

Raise the alarm.

The Stable Manager will ensure that the Fire Brigade are notified.

Public address announcements will give clear evacuation announcements.

Stewards will assist the security and event managers in crowd control.

The show director will co-ordinate and evaluate the situation.

The show director will liaise with the Fire Brigade on their arrival.

Follow instructions from the Senior Fire Officer present.

26. Miscellaneous Show Information

- a) **Team Dressage and Showjumping.** In addition to the Loriners Inter-Service Team leg there will be a Team SJ and Team Dr competition. These will be for teams of 3 riders with all scores counting and when combined together result in the best team (lowest SJ results and highest Dr %) winning.
 - The Team Showjumping will be run at class 26 (sections a, b and c). It requires individual riders to enter themselves at the height they wish to jump and include the name of the Team they will form part of.
 - The Team Dressage will be run over classes 20, 21, 22, 23 and 25 (a & b). 3 different horse/rider combinations can enter these classes as individuals with 1 of each competing at one of the Class levels. Team riders are to add their Team name (making it clear on what horse they wish to be considered if riding multiple horses) to their entry.
- b) **Top Showjumping and Dressage awards.** In recognition of significantly consistent performances across 2 days of competition the following awards will be made at the end of show prizegiving presentation:
 - Top Military (Regular or Reserve) Dressage combination
 - Top Military (Regular or Reserve) Showjumping combination
 - Top Police Sport UK Dressage combination
 - Top Police Sport UK Showjumping combination
 - Top Blue Lights GB (other emergency services (non PSUK) riders including other U.K. protective services riders) Dressage combination
 - Top Blue Lights GB (other emergency services (non PSUK) riders including other U.K. protective services riders) Show jumping combination



Performance criteria:

Dressage. The combination across the 2 days who places consistently highly in their 2 best scoring Dressage tests (including Inter-Service Leg) at the same level.

(In the event of a tie the combination with the highest number of collective marks over their best Test will differentiate).

Showjumping. The combination who based upon SJ placings across the 2 days accrues the highest number of points in individual (not Team Class 26) classes across one height level. Additional points are awarded for double clears - see points table below:

- Only the 2 best scores count across classes at 85cm.

(In the event of a tie the greatest cumulative time difference between the combinations best placed result and their next highest placed competitor will differentiate.)

c) **Blue Lights of GB Top Rider Perpetual Shield.** This will be awarded to the Police, NHS, or Fire and Rescue (Warranted or Volunteer) same horse/rider combination who on aggregate scoring, based on points to placings (see below) conversion across all disciplines scores the highest overall total.

27. Demonstration

There will be a mounted demonstration by Anne Marie Bork Eppers in the Addington International Indoor Arena on Monday 11 September. This will entail introducing a number of her horses in training through the levels for Dressage; including TBs undergoing the re-training process. All competitors are invited to attend and the audience can expect to gain helpful insights and tips into the process including the nuances of preparing off the track TBs for their new careers. The time will be confirmed when entries have closed.

28. UK Armed Forces Equestrian Association's AGM

Military personnel are encouraged to attend the AGM which will be held at the venue during the show. More details will be circulated through single Service Equitation Associations.
